


# Status of FAA Performance Targets

### Commentary (06/2004)

The FAA is currently executing two Bilateral Aviation Safety Agreements (BASAs):

- The pending BASA Executive Agreement with Australia is being considered a "treaty" by the Australian Government and is being reviewed by its Parliament. Consequently, the BASA may not be concluded in FY 2004.
- FAA and Department of State are reviewing comments from the Government of Iceland concerning the proposed BASA agreement that was delivered to Iceland in January 2004.
