**PART 302-44—ALLOWANCE FOR EMERGENCY STORAGE OF A PRIVATELY OWNED AUTOMOBILE**

- § 302-44.1**      **What is the purpose of the allowance for emergency storage of a POA?**      To protect a POA transported at Government expense to your post of duty when FAA determines that the post of duty is within a zone from which your immediate family and/or household goods should be evacuated.
- § 302-44.2**      **Must my agency authorize emergency storage of my POA?**      No. FAA determines the conditions under which it will pay for emergency storage and the procedures a relocated employee must follow.
- § 302-44.3**      **When am I eligible for emergency storage of my POA?**      You are eligible when:
- (a) You were authorized to transport a POA to your post of duty at Government expense;
  - (b) You either:
    - (1) Transported your POA to your post of duty at Government expense; or
    - (2) Purchase a POA locally after being authorized to purchase a POA locally instead of transporting a POA to your post of duty; and
  - (c) The Associate Administrator for Policy, Planning, and International Aviation determines that your post of duty is within a zone from which your immediate family and/or household goods should be evacuated.
- § 302-44.4**      **Where may I store my POA if I receive notice to evacuate my immediate family and/or household goods from my post of duty?**      You may store your POA at a place determined to be reasonable by FAA whether the POA is already located at, or being transported to, your post of duty.

| § 302-44.5 | <b>What type of POA may I be authorized to store if necessary under emergency circumstances?</b> | Only a passenger automobile, station wagon, small truck, or other similar vehicle that will be used primarily for personal transportation. You may not transport or store a trailer, airplane, or any vehicle intended for commercial use.  |
| § 302-44.6 | <b>For what POA emergency storage expenses will my agency pay?</b>                               | All necessary storage expenses, including but not limited to readying the POA for storage, local transportation to point of storage, storage, readying the POA for use after storage, and local transportation from the point of storage. Insurance on the POA is at your expense, unless it is included in the expenses allowed by this paragraph. |
| § 302-44.7 | <b>May I receive an advance of funds for emergency storage of my POA?</b>                        | Yes, in an amount not to exceed the estimated amount of the expenses authorized under this part for transportation and emergency storage of your POA.   |
