


# Status of FAA Performance Targets

### Commentary (09/2004)

In FY2004 there were 13 FAA/AST licensed launches. Of these 13 launches, 4 involved Scaled Composites' SpaceShipOne. These flights were the first licensed launches of a Reusable Launch Vehicle, and the first manned commercial rocket launches. As part of the license evaluation process, AST reviewed the planned vehicle trajectories to ensure that densely populated areas on the ground were not put at risk. Each launch was conducted safely, resulting in no (zero) instances of fatalities or serious injuries. The 13 launches in FY 2004 extended the total licensed launches without a fatality or serious injury to 166.
