
### Notice of OPM Policy Information

**AGENCIES:** This notice announces an extension of the personnel interchange agreement between the Federal Aviation Administration and the Competitive Civil Service

**Heads of Departments and Independent Establishments:**

1. The personnel interchange agreement that permits movement between the competitive civil service and positions in the Federal Aviation Administration has been extended. The Office of Personnel Management has approved extension of the agreement through July 1, 2005. Attached is a copy of the original agreement which is unchanged except for the new expiration date.

2. The agreement covers movement of both current FAA employees and FAA employees who are appointed noncompetitively within 1 year following an involuntary separation without personal cause. In determining employees' eligibility for noncompetitive appointment, all qualifying FAA service is creditable, including service before the effective date of this agreement. Eligible FAA employees may be appointed in any agency and receive credit for their FAA service toward career tenure.
